Wanted: Readers willing to discuss mutual funds with a planner

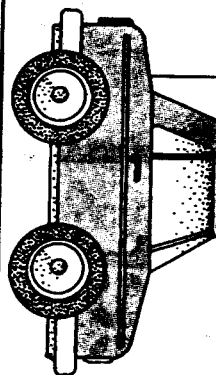
Ever thought about investing in a mutual fund but haven't taken the plunge?
